



## Farmer's Market Booth Rental Policies

Note: All booths that sell something must have items at their booth that are home-made or home-grown. Other items may be sold but booth must sell traditional Farmer's Market items. This includes bakery items, canned items, hand-crafted items, home-grown produce etc.

1. Booth Rental: \$20 per Saturday or \$150 for the summer plan. Payment plan for summer plan is \$20 per Saturday with payment in full by last Saturday in June. (For example, this year it would be June 24, 2017).
2. Free booth available for booths that are informational, educational or public service but cannot have items for sale. They can have items to give away.
3. Non-profit fundraising booth space is available for free for up to three Saturdays during the season for 501C3 non-profit organizations and churches. After the three free Saturdays, the non-profits and churches will be expected to pay the non-profit rate of \$10 a Saturday or \$150 for the summer.
4. Youth groups, clubs, school groups, civic organizations, services organizations, etc. are eligible for the non-profit rate of \$10 per Saturday.
5. Families raising money for documented medical debt will be allowed free booth space as available.
6. A guest vendor booth, which can be shared for up to three vendors, is available each Saturday. A guest vendor can use this booth two times for \$10 each time. Space is assigned on a first-reserve basis.
